Toddlers

Toddler Story Point:

Jesus is alive!

Toddler Big Picture Question:

Who is alive?

Jesus is alive!

Toddler Christ Connection:

Jesus brings forgiveness and life with God forever.

Bible Story for Babies and Toddlers:

Two men were walking to a village. While they were walking, they talked about Jesus and all the things that had happened.

Suddenly, Jesus began walking with them, but they did not recognize Him. Jesus asked the men what they were talking about. They told Jesus what had happened. They said that Jesus had died on the cross and been buried in a tomb, but that the tomb was empty. When they arrived in the village, they did not want Jesus to leave. The men asked Jesus to stay with them. During the meal, the men finally recognized Him. Then Jesus disappeared.

The two men hurried back to Jerusalem. They told Jesus' friends and others what happened to them. They told that they saw Jesus. He was alive!

Elementary

Elementary Story Point:

Jesus died on the cross and then came back to life.

Elementary Big Picture Question:

Who saves us from our sin?

Jesus saves us from our sin.

Elementary Christ Connection:

The most important thing that ever happened is that Jesus died and was raised from the dead. Jesus is alive! When we turn from sin and trust in Jesus, we have hope and new life. Jesus brings forgiveness and life with God forever.

Bible Story

—Based on Luke 24:13-35

Two men were walking to a village called Emmaus. While they were walking, they talked about Jesus and all the things that had happened.

Suddenly, Jesus began walking with them, but they did not recognize Him. Jesus asked the men what they were discussing. The men could not believe He did not know what had happened. They told Jesus what had been going on. They told Him about the tomb and about what happened with the women.

Jesus kept walking with them. Jesus taught the men about what the Scriptures said about Himself.

When they arrived in Emmaus, they did not want Jesus to leave. The men asked Jesus to stay with them, and Jesus agreed to stay.

During the meal, Jesus gave thanks for the bread, broke it, and gave it to the men.

When Jesus did this, the men finally recognized Him. Then Jesus disappeared.

The two men hurried back to Jerusalem. They told the disciples and others what happened to them. They told that they saw Jesus.

Discussion Questions

1. Did the two men know that Jesus was with them?
2. What were the two men talking about when Jesus started walking with them?
3. What did Jesus do when the men realized who he was?
4. What did the men do after they realized who Jesus was?
5. Can we tell the good news that Jesus is alive too?

Family Activities

Go on a walk together

As you go on a family walk retell the Bible story.

Say: Today in our story two men were walking to a village when Jesus started walking with them! Use this time to review the Bible story together as well. Ask your child what they remember about the story. Ask what they would tell people about Jesus.

Paint a stone

Invite your child to find a stone and decorate it.

Say: In our story today two men were walking with Jesus, but they didn't realize it was him! They told him about how Jesus had died on the cross and was buried in a tomb. Remind children that the stone was rolled away from the entrance of the tomb and people saw that Jesus was alive!
