Responsibilities:

Family & Kids Discipleship

- Oversee Kids Sunday and Wednesday discipleship programming
- Help equip parents in their primary role in discipling their children within their home by providing discipleship tools, recommended resources, and organizing special events.
- Oversee the discipleship and mentoring of children and teens with intentional growth in the Family Ministry discipleship strategy.
- Choose discipleship curriculum in coordination with the Associate Pastor of Equipping
- Lead with passion and resourcing for leading kids to a personal faith in Jesus.
- Teach regularly within the Sunday and Wednesday teacher rotation.

Family Community & Care

- Partner with Community Group Leaders to provide genuine friendship, encouragement, and support for all parents and families
- Intentionally plan family-specific opportunities and events outside of Sunday morning that encourage spiritual growth and connections
- Serve as the primary communicator and liaison between church staff, elders, and families.
- Oversee communication with volunteers and families to build relationships, mentor, and provide reminders and encouragement.
- Ensure visiting families understand the process of committing to ICC and are connected to discovery classes.
- Celebrate special events in the lives of families and kids (birthdays, holidays, new babies, etc.)
- Provide care and support for families within our church

Family Ministry Leadership (Organization & Volunteers)

- Recruit, train, and mentor Family Ministry Volunteers for Sunday and Wednesday ministry
- Prepare volunteers for effective lesson preparation and teaching
- Prepare curriculum, lesson plans, supplies, and media for Sundays and Wednesdays
- Oversee the coordination of volunteer rotation and scheduling, ensuring classrooms are fully staffed and resourced.
- Coordinate volunteers for special events, such as worship services, family meetings, and community groups.
- Personally fill in for volunteer gaps as needed
- Ensure Family Ministry practices meet safety, legal compliance, and other expectations in cooperation with our Caring Well Leadership guidelines.

Additional Responsibilities

- Represent the family ministry vision, needs, and events in all staff meetings and communications.
