Responsibilities:

Outreach

- Work to cultivate an evangelistic culture among students in our church.
- Provide vision for the church for reaching the lost on the campuses in our city.
- Work to equip, encourage, and empower students towards missional living.
- Develop a strategic approach to engagement and visibility that offers evangelistic opportunities on our campuses.
- Develop and lead Student Outreach Team(s) to create regular connection points on campuses.
- Provide clear pathways for students to take their "next step" in connecting to our church body.
- Maintain regular personal presence on campuses.
- Survey and establish ministry partnerships that maximize opportunities for our church to engage with students in the community.

Discipleship

- Discipleship and encouragement of student leaders.
- Work with Associate Pastor of Discipleship to organize and oversee student Community Groups for effective discipleship of students.

- Help to assimilate visiting and prospective students into church life, especially rhythms of discipleship (Community Groups and Learning Environments).
- Serve as a pastoral touchpoint for students in the life of the church.
- Regular check-ins with students during exams, breaks, etc. to care for them in specific seasons.
- Cultivate opportunities for students to grow in their love for Jesus, knowledge of the Scriptures, and missional opportunity on their campuses.
- Develop events to build community and foster discipleship among students in the life of the church.
- Develop and lead Student Discipleship Team(s) to invest intentionally in students.

Mobilization

- Provide visionary leadership for students to grow in service, leadership, and kingdomminded missional living.
- Provide vision for the church to prioritize and support ministry toward students.
- Help students discover their spiritual gifts and find opportunities to serve and lead in the church.
- Help students connect to opportunities to serve locally in our city as well as globally.
- Work to equip students for kingdom living and help them find pathways for development of their gifts and skills.
- Execute annual student graduation commissioning and induction into the ICC Legacy Club.
- Oversee and develop the ICC Legacy Club and relationships with Legacy Partners.
- Develop and lead Student Mobilization Team(s) as well as working with staff leaders in Local Ministry and Global Missions.

Additional Staff Responsibilities
