THROUGH THE WAY WE TREAT PEOPLE TO THE WAY WE SOLVE CRITICAL PROBLEMS PLAGUING OUR CITY, OUR HANDS ARE READY TO BE USED HOWEVER THE LORD SEES FIT. SOMETIMES THAT INVOLVES BRINGING OUR MESSY SELVES TO MESSY SITUATIONS AND TRUSTING THAT GOD WILL DO THE WORK.

- OUR WORSHIP THAT RALLIES AROUND THE CENTRALITY OF JESUS.
- OUR BELIEF THAT JESUS IS THE WAY, THE TRUTH, AND THE LIFE FOR ALL PEOPLE, EVERYWHERE.

KEY VERSES: GALATIANS 3:28, ACTS 17:26, REVELATION 7:9

WE ARE WILLING TO GO SLOW.

WE WANT TO DO THINGS AT THE PACE THAT GOD IS WORKING. WE DO NOT DESIRE TO GET AHEAD OF GOD OR FALL BEHIND. WE ARE WILLING TO BE PATIENT YET PRODUCTIVE AS WE SEE GOD MOVING. IF CHANGE TAKES TIME, THEN WE WILL BE A CHURCH THAT IS CONSISTENTLY IN IT FOR THE LONG HAUL. WE WILL BE DELIBERATE AND EXERCISE PATIENCE IN VARIOUS ASPECTS OF MINISTRY.

WE WAGE PEACE.

WE DESIRE TO SEEK PEACE IN OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH ONE ANOTHER AND OUR CITY. THE BIBLE ENCOURAGES US TO ACTIVELY SEEK PEACE AND EMPHASIZES RESOLVING CONFLICTLS PEACEFULLY, PURSUING RECONCILIATION, AND LIVING IN HARMONY WITH OTHERS. WE DESIRE TO BE A COMMUNITY THAT FORGIVES WITH HUMILITY COMMITTED TO FOSTERING PEACE AND JUSTICE.

- THE BIBLICAL PATH TO SOLVE CONFLICT AS A CHURCH BODY.
- THE GOSPEL MESSAGE WE PROCLAIM OF RECONCILIATION TO GOD THROUGH JESUS.


