***“Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus”  
(1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 NIV).***

Church family, as Paul wrote to the believers in Thessalonica, we understand that they were facing some difficult days. Like many of Paul’s epistles, this one is especially important as Paul sought to encourage new believers as they faced trials, to give instruction regarding godly living and to give assurance regarding believers who die before Christ returns.

These verses are especially encouraging to me during these days in which we find ourselves and I pray they will be for you as well.

As we examine these three verses, notice that Paul says that we are to ***rejoice always***. We know that the life of the believer was never promised to be easy; in fact we know that we will face testing, trials and even persecution. It is because of the hope that is ours in Christ Jesus that we can rejoice always, for we have been secured in our salvation and await eternal life with Him.

Paul further encourages us to ***pray continually*** or pray without ceasing. We want to be people who cultivate a spirit of continual prayer so that our hearts might be attuned to Christ. I would ask you to be praying for many things as we walk through these days together.

Continue to pray for Candi, Katie & Tyler and the extended Tilley family. Continue to pray for our church that we might follow the leading of the Holy Spirit in all decisions that are made. Continue to pray that our church might keep the focus of honoring and glorifying Christ in all things that we do. Continue to pray for those in leadership positions that we might lead in a way that Christ would be the head of the body. Continue to pray that we would have a spirit of unity in our church.

Lastly, we are to be a people who ***give thanks in all circumstances***. I am reminded each day with just how much God has blessed me with – more than I could ever thank Him. I pray that I might have a spirit of thanksgiving and as testimony, recognize that it should be our desire to be in God’s perfect will. We are reminded - “And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose” (Romans 8:28 NIV).

As we walk through these days together, let us be a people who follow the encouragement of the apostle Paul and keep our eyes fixed on Jesus!
