I. The problem of Bread vs. 1-4

(John 5:19, Matthew 4:4, Deuteronomy 8:3)

II. The problem of Authority vs. 5-8

(Psalm 2:6-12, Daniel 7:13-14, Hebrews 10:12-13, Exodus 20:3-5)

III. The problem of Testimony vs. 9-13

(Psalm 91:9-12, Deuteronomy 6:16, James 1:13-14, Hebrews 4:15, 1 John 2:16, Genesis 3:6, Ephesians 2:17)

- 6. Inquire about and pray for one another.**
