Hosea 2 The Pictured Explained

I.	The need to warn vs. 1-2 (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12, Ezekiel 33:6, Proverbs 24:24-25, Acts 20:28, Hebrews 10:24-25, Colossians 3:16)
II.	Why this picture? vs. 3-6 (Leviticus 26:39, 17:16, Genesis 15:16, Ezekiel 16:20-22, Jeremiah 2:24-25, Proverbs 22:5, Isaiah 30:20-21)
