Hosea 4 Infidelity Played Out

I. The loss of knowing vs. 4:1

(Deuteronomy 6:1-9, Isaiah 5:13, Jeremiah 4:22)

II. Death by ignorance 4:2-6

(Isaiah 24:4-6, Numbers 35:33, Jeremiah 2:7, Leviticus 18:24-25, Romans 8:20-21, Romans 7:7)

III. The failed fathers vs. 4:7-17

(Isaiah 56:11, 1:2-3, Genesis 38:24-26, Hebrews 12:8)
