Hosea 7 Foreign and Domestic Faith

I. Internal affairs vs. 7:1-7

(Jeremiah 51:9, Micah 7:2-3, Jeremiah 6:7)

II. Foreign affairs 7:8-10

(Leviticus 19:34, Exodus 12:49, Leviticus 24:22, Numbers 15:15, Deuteronomy 1:16-17)

III. Consequential foolishness vs. 7:11-16

(Matthew 10:16, Joshua 24:14, 2 Corinthians 1:12, 1 Timothy 1:5, Psalm 78:41-42, 35-37)

Conclusion:

Questions to facilitate discussion, reflection and fellowship.

- 1. Was there any part of the sermon that stood out or requires clarification?**
- 2. What from the sermon provides example for living a consistent life for Christ?**
- 3. Hosea 7:3 states the leaders are made happy by evil. How can we recognize bad leaders and what can be done when leaders are evil? (Hebrews 13:17, 2 John 1:9, Ephesians 6:12, Proverbs 29:2, 16:12)**
- 4. Hosea 7:8-10 speaks about the dangers of Israel's mixing with foreign influence. How does scripture call us to deal with this challenge? (Exodus 12:49, Numbers 15:15, Deuteronomy 1:16-17)**
- 5. Verse 14 states that they do not cry to the Lord from their hearts. Discuss keeping the Lord central in your life.**
- 6. Inquire about and pray for one another.**
