

I. A warning blast vs. 8:1-3

(Matthew 24:8, Isaiah 59:2, Romans 1:28)

II. On missing the signal vs. 8:4-8

(1 Kings 14:8-10, 2 Kings 17:16, Galatians 6:7-8, Luke 6:7-10, Ezekiel 23:30, Jeremiah 22:28)

III. Going the wrong way vs. 8:9-14


(Ezekiel 16:26-29, 1 Kings 12:28, Deuteronomy 31:26)

Questions to facilitate discussion, reflection and fellowship.

- 1. Was there any part of the sermon that stood out or requires clarification?**
- 2. What from the sermon provides example for living a consistent life for Christ?**
- 3. Hosea 8:3 states that Israel spurned the good. What are some ways we kid ourselves, or spurn the goodness of God? (Isaiah 59:2, Romans 1:28)**
- 4. Hosea 8:4-6 highlights how Israel decided to do things their own way, discuss how to avoid this mistake, and what to do about it. (Galatians 6:7-8)**
- 5. Discuss ways you have or can live as a vessel to the Lord. (2 Timothy 2:19-26)**
- 6. Inquire about and pray for one another.**
