II. Stale bread and foreign lands vs. 9:4-9

(Exodus 6:6, Isaiah 31:1, Jeremiah 44:1)

III. The despised of God vs. 9:10-17

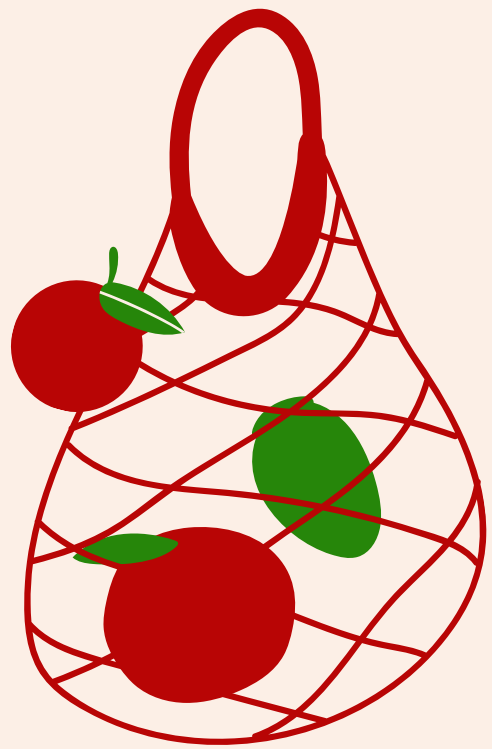
