l.	A time to branch out vs. 10:1-4 (Leviticus 26:3-4, John 15:8, 16, 19:14-16)
II.	Twigs and Thorns vs. 10:5-10 (Jeremiah 17:9-10, Matthew 3:10, Revelation 6:16-17, 2 Kings 17:5-6, Jude 7, Deuteronomy 28:47)
III.	Ploughing for results vs. 10:9-15 (Deuteronomy 32:15, Jeremiah 4:3, Galatians 6:7-10, Amos 3:11)

Questions to facilitate discussion, reflection, and fellowship.
1. Was there any part of the sermon that stood out or requires clarification?
2. What from the sermon provides an example of, or living for, Christ?
3. Read John 15:8 and discuss why the Lord seems to expect fruit from his people. (Matthew 3:10)
