I. Alarm alarm! vs. 2:1-3

(2 Samuel 5:7, Psalm 87:1-2, Jeremiah 31:6, Deuteronomy 28:58-62, Matthew 22:13, 13:42, Psalm 107:33-34)

II. Dreadful appearances vs. 2:4-11

(Deuteronomy 17:16-20, Job 39:19-25, Exodus 10:21-23, Isaiah 13:10-11, Proverbs 21:31)

III. On call vs. 2:12-17

(Hosea 6:1-2, Psalm 103:8, 111:4, Luke 18:13-14, Psalm 18:6, Acts 17:30, Luke 13:3, 1 John 1:9, Job 1:20-21)

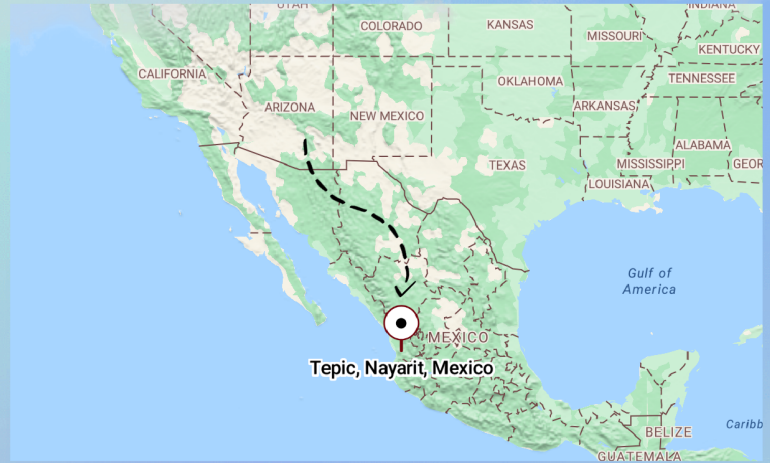
Conclusion:

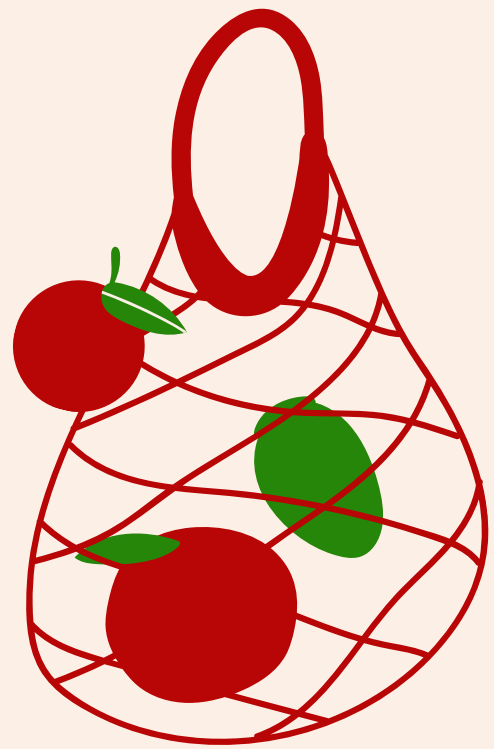

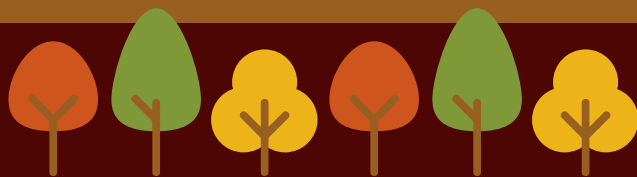
