Amos 7 Dividing Words

(Exodus 10:13-15, Genesis 19:23-25, Isaiah 28:17)
Hard to handle vs. 10-13 (1 Kings 18:17-18, 22:8, Matthew 14:3-5)
The speaker's woe vs. 14-17 (Ezekiel 2:4-7, Matthew 5:11-12, Jeremiah 17:14-15)
