


Hosea 7 Foreign and Domestic Faith



Questions to facilitate discussion, reflection and fellowship.
1. Was there any part of the sermon that stood out or requires clarification?
2. What from the sermon provides example for living a consistent life for Christ?
3. Hosea 7:3 states the leaders are made happy by evil. How can we recognize bad leaders and what can be done when leaders are evil? (Hebrews 13:17, 2 John 1:9, Ephesians 6:12, Proverbs 29:2, 16:12)
4. Hosea 7:8-10 speaks about the dangers of Israel's mixing with foreign influence. How does scripture call us to deal with this challenge? (Exodus 12:49, Numbers 15:15, Deuteronomy 1:16-17)
5. Verse 14 states that they do no cry to the Lord from their hearts. Discuss keeping the Lord central in your life.
6. Inquire about and pray for one another.
