I. A move of compassion vs. 2:18-20

II. The great restoration vs. 2:21-27

(Isaiah 51:3, James 5:7, Zechariah 10:1, Hosea 6:3)

III. Later spiritual blessing vs. 2:28-32

(Psalm 51:7-12, 16-17, Isaiah 63:3, Acts 2:16-18, John 1:32, 3:3-5, 3:34, 2 Corinthians 1:21-22, Acts 2:19-21, Matthew 24:2, 29-31, Romans 10:11-13)
