## Joel 3 Revenge and Restore

I.	Enemies not overlooked vs. 3:1-8 (Zechariah 14:2, Amos 1:6, 9, Ezekiel 27:22, Habakkuk 2:8)
II.	The Warring Picture vs. 3:9-16 (Micah 4:3, Zephaniah 3:8, Isaiah 13:4-5, Lamentations 1:15, Isaiah 63:3, Genesis 8:21-22, Jeremiah 31:35-36, Isaiah 13:10)
III	. So that you will know vs. 3:17-21 (Amos 1:2, Deuteronomy 28:13, Obadiah 3-4, Deuteronomy 32:43, Romans 12:19 Acts 17:29-31)
