“At the Other Table” by Larry Sullivan

The words she heard were devastating. Sitting in the booth of a restaurant, the young girl overheard a group of her peers mentioning her name. They didn't know she was there. As she overheard, she felt herself falling to pieces. Their words were not true and their insinuations were false. She would never have been involved in such things and yet, that is exactly what was being passed around “at the other table.” The weeks that followed were excruciating. The looks, the sneers and the whispers were unbearable. Yet no one came to her to confirm, confess or to comfort. It was the loneliest school year she had ever experienced.

Gossip often begins as a “harmless” repetition of something we hear from someone else. Too often it grows into a fire that causes damage and injury on many levels. Its appetite is insatiable and it leaves devastation wherever it goes.

In the world of Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat or Twitter, and other forms of social media, a thought or a word can instantly broadcast to the four corners of earth – and once it is out there ... it can't be retrieved. I ask myself, why is it so hard for us to go to people privately first instead of sharing information with others? I am talking about information that can be belittling, damaging or down right destructive. Listen to these wise words:

Proverbs 17:9 “Whoever would foster love covers over an offense, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends.”

Proverbs 26:22 “The words of a gossip are like choice morsels . . . “

But one of my favorites is two verses before that, in **26:20** ***“without wood a fire goes out; without gossip a quarrel dies down.”***

Can we somehow kill that desire to spread gossip? Can we squelch the voice that says “I've got to tell someone else?” Can we stop feeding the fire that may feel warm when we start it, but can quickly spread to an uncontrollable wild fire?

“Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouth, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs . . .” Ephesians 4:29
