CAN WE TRUST GOD IN THIS?

The knock on the door seemed desperate. The messenger rushed inside with the message: “The Sabeans came riding up and stole your entire flock of oxen and donkeys, and- and- they killed all your servants. I am the only survivor!” No sooner had he finished those words than another knock came. This messenger brought an equally disturbing message; “Fire came from heaven and burned up all your sheep and all the shepherds! I am the only survivor!” You know how the story goes on. The next messenger told that all his camels had been stolen. The messenger was the only survivor. The next reported the loss of all of his children and grandchildren. Again, the messenger was the only survivor.

Faced with the loss of everything he had, everything but his life and his wavering faith in God, Job fought with doubt. He fought with the big question that we often find ourselves asking; “Why, God?” There is nothing frivolous about suffering loss. The feeling of being the “only survivor” when such losses occur is real. The “empty space” that losing a loved one creates is real, and dealing with it seems an impossible task.

Through the real pain, the tears and the loss, I want to encourage us to keep six powerful words in our minds, and on our lips: “We can trust God in this!” Searching for the “why” can often only discourage us more. Searching for God in all this can lead us to comfort and peace.

Faced with a lot of questions about why things happen the way they do, Job responded “***I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted.***” Habakkuk, another believer who fought with the “why” question, finally resolved to respond to God in trusting faith. I may not understand the “why”, but I can trust God in this!

“ . . .yet will I rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in my Savior” (Habakkuk 3:18)
