___ **Moderator:** Preside at quarterly business meetings as well as others if necessary.

___ **Technology:** Provide technical support for church systems.

___ **Buildings & Grounds Committee:** Maintenance of all church property.

___ **Long Range Planning Committee:** Develop plans to support church ministries. (Members serve 3 year terms)

___ **Personnel Committee:** Provide Human Resources support for church staff. Nine meetings / year and staff evaluations. (Members serve 3 year terms)

___ **Finance Committee:** Monitor church finances. Attend 6-8 meetings / year. (Members serve 3 year terms)
