It is an honor to be serving West Haven on the Missions Team this year! I have always had a passion for missions on a local and cross-cultural level. I pray that the Missions Team can put together ways for you and your family to fuel your passion to serve God missionally this year.

Acts 1:8 says, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." By following this we hope to serve God in our immediate community, Kansas City and cross-culturally.

Locally, we desire to continue to support "Be The Church," where we reach our neighbors for Christ. We are currently looking into how to support those with a heart for foster care. There will be information about that to come in the future months!

We will continue to support the House of God Community Church, a West African church plant in North Kansas City. We co-hosted an eyeglass clinic with them on Jan. 23 and the Lord blessed! We plan on having a joint worship on a Sunday evening this summer as a next step in their growth.

We are also excited to be sending a team to Mexico again **July 9th-15th**! It has been a few years since we have been able to send a large group to help out Steve Smith and Focus on Missions in Matamoros, Mexico. We have been working with Steve in Mexico since 2007. Sarah Laundry will lead an informational meeting immediately after church on **Feb. 21** in the Train Station. Our Missions 5K will be in May to support the Mexico trip this year so keep your eyes out for the upcoming date!

The GIO gives 25% of to the Southern Baptist Convention's International Mission Board that supports foreign missions. Another 25% goes to the North American Mission Board that funds church plants and missionaries in the United States. The last 50% remains in the West Haven Missions fund which has been used to assist The House of God Community Church and the work in Matamoros.

Our intention is not to clutter your schedule but to give you an opportunity to take part in God's mission for his people – to be His witnesses in our community, Kansas City and Cross-Culturally. Please be in prayer about how God is calling you and your family to be involved.
