I'm glad to see you today. Let's open to Psalm 90 and Colossians 4 today and examine the subject of time. In Psalm 90, Moses tells us to "number our days." In Colossians, Paul tells us to "conduct ourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of every opportunity." We have an emergency, an urgency and a responsibility. The emergency is that people need Jesus. The urgency is that they need Him before they die. The responsibility is to talk to them about Jesus. We only have a short time to do that. Adrian Rogers said, "Yesterday is history, tomorrow is a mystery. Today is all we have." Let's look this morning at God's Word and how to maximize the time God has graciously provided.

Today I want to challenge you to go with Pastor Ryon and me on a 7-day media/digital fast. Take the extra time to be in the Word and prayer. See what God does in those 7 days. I think you'll be amazed. Send me an email and let me know what God does in your life.

I was reminded this week of the incredible faithfulness of God. Many of you know that shortly after Tara and I were married, I became very ill. There was really no reason to believe I would live past my mid-30s. One of my fervent prayers was that Jesus would let me live long enough to raise my children. Guess what? He is the faithful One. He is still on the throne. Prayer changes things. Do not grow weary or fainthearted in your walk with Him!

Associate Pastor's Note



A good example of scheduling allows for interruptions and transition times. Scheduling extra time allows us to minister should the need arise, and it allows us to notice people around us during times of transition. Scheduling things back to back removes almost all opportunities, because we are consumed by our next task. I experienced both sides of scheduling last week. I left our home early in the morning only leaving a slight window to pick up donuts for FCA before heading to the middle school. I was rushing out of Casey's when I notice a man had locked his keys in his car. I wanted to stop and help him, but I didn't have one extra second of time. If I scheduled leaving home 10 minutes earlier I would have had time to minister. That same morning I walked out of the middle school after FCA and I saw two legs hanging out of a trunk. It was a guy that needed some help changing a tire. I always schedule a little transition time between FCA and the office, so I had the extra time to stop and invest in someone. I have found most ministry takes place in the time between events and programs. I call it scheduling ministry opportunities rather than transition time, because it reminds me I need to be available for whoever God puts in my path.
