

Pastor's Note

***For the Spirit's comfort and presence with those who are ill, downtrodden, weary and lonely.** For West Haven members to be the hands and feet of Jesus to those people.

If our Lord can create a cosmos from nothing, He can certainly answer these prayers. Paul said he is "able to do far more abundantly than all we ask or think." What do you need the faith to ask God for?


