#### **Bringing it Home**



- 1) Read John 1:1-5 and Mark 4:1-20. Ask God to speak to you by his Spirit through his Word.
- 2) Jesus compares his Word to a "seed." What does that imagery convey?

3) What are you planting in the soil of your heart?

4) Receiving Jesus and his Word is NOT just a onetime thing. It is something we need to do continually. Is your heart good soil? If not, what is keeping you from receiving Jesus and his Word?
