This week's tool is studying the Bible. A Bible study takes content from scripture and then asks the reader to respond to questions based on what they read. For this week, we will be reading the story of Gideon and his 300 men and then responding to the following questions.

Read Judges 7 and then answer the questions below.

1. Why did God reduce the number of men fighting against the Midianites?
2. Is it bad to be confident in your accomplishments?
3. Where do you draw the line between good pride and negative pride?
4. Why did God want Gideon to go down to the camp?
5. Has God ever given you encouragement or a sign of hope? When was that?
6. What might the Israelites have thought as they were going to battle with 300 men and a bunch of jars?
7. Our Bible Project study is all about understanding the Bible as a whole and reading Scripture in context. What questions might someone have if there were reading this one chapter by itself and did not understand the rest of the story?
8. What questions do you have about this chapter by not reading the surrounding chapters?
