

Indoor Worship Gathering Details



How many gatherings will there be? Two gatherings at 9:00 and 10:30.

We will monitor attendance and decide if a third service is required in the future.



What will we do? We will gather for fellowship, singing, and teaching.

Both services will be live-streamed in their entirety for those worshipping at home or out of town.



Which parts of the service will be live? Services will be fully live.

Both preaching and musical worship will be live.



What style will the worship music be? We will return to distinct music styles in the services.

The 9:00 service will feature a more traditional music style while 10:30 will be more contemporary.



Where will we gather? The main gathering spot will be the Sanctuary.

Overflow seating will also be available in the main lobby.



How many people will there be? There will be no capacity limit for the services.

The Sanctuary will be set up with both rows of seats and tables in the back for those who prefer more space.



Will I have time to fellowship with others? Yes, both in the Sanctuary and elsewhere.

There will be space in the lobby and patio for extended conversations before or after the services.



Is there kids ministry? Yes, during the 10:30 service only.

Ministry for preschool through 6th grade will be offered. The nursery will be open but not staffed during both services.



Will coffee be served? Not yet.

We will look to resume our coffee ministry in the future.



Are masks required? No, masks are optional for those who prefer them.

We ask that everyone respect those who prefer to remain masked.



Can I watch from home? Yes. Online services will be available at both 9:00 and 10:30.
