YOUR ROLE

Some of the specific tasks you may be involved in, depending on your gifts and calling, are:

- Planning and execution of large outreach events such as our annual MEGA Sports Camp (400+ kids and 150+ volunteers), Easter Egg Hunt, and fall Autumn Extravaganza.
- Leadership of one or more areas of Sunday morning discipleship ministries (early childhood, elementary, tween).
- Coordination and leadership of our Sunday evening AWANA Clubs.
- Administrative support for weekly nextgen ministries.
- Leadership development and care for nextgen ministry volunteer teams.
- Effective communication with and support for parents through print resources, social media, and parenting seminars.

EXPECTATIONS

The NextGen Ministry Assistant should bring the following character and gifts to the role:

- Personal faith in Jesus Christ and active participant in a local church congregation.
- Passion for the next generation
- A desire to pursue vocational ministry.
- Proficient in technology use (MS Office, Google Drive, social media).
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.

The role will begin at part time hours (roughly 15-20 hours per week, to be discussed with the applicant) at a pay rate commensurate with experience. There is a possibility of growth to a full time role in the future.
