

# Outdoor Worship Service Details



## **When are we holding outdoor services?** Through Sunday October 25th

Details on what will happen starting in November will be communicated soon.



## **How many services will there be?** A single service at 10:00 AM

We are holding just a single outdoor service in the month of October to take advantage of warmer late-morning weather.



## **Where will I sit?** On the grass in the front of the church.

Bring your own blanket, lawn chairs, and sun shade if you want. Some canopies will be provided for those who need shade.



## **Can I stay in my car?** Yes. Some parking spaces will be reserved with a good view of the stage.

You can listen to the audio by tuning your radio to FM 99.3



## **Do I need to sign up?** No.

We have had a good balance between the two services, so unless we begin getting crowded, we will not require signups.



## **Can I watch from home?** Yes. The service will be live streamed.

You can watch via the website or Facebook Live.



## **What will we do?** A full worship service including fellowship, singing, and teaching.

We ask that you respect people's individual preferences for space and physical contact.



## **Are masks required?** Masks should be worn when near others but not while in your space.

We ask you to wear a mask when socializing, moving to/from your space, using the bathroom, etc.



## **Will bathrooms be open?** Yes. We have bathrooms open inside. Follow signs to the right.

We ask that you wear your mask when going to/from the bathroom and wash your hands thoroughly.



## **Is there any kids ministry?** Yes, during the 9am service only.

We are hosting outdoor preschool and elementary ministries during the 9am service. Visit the Alliance Kids page for more.



## **What if it rains?** Services will be streamed online if they need to be canceled due to weather.

Announcements will be made by email, Facebook, and the church website by 7:30am on Sunday morning if needed.



## **Who shouldn't come?** Please watch from home if you might be a risk to others.

Please don't come to the services if you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, had symptoms, been exposed to someone sick, or traveled somewhere for which Pennsylvania recommends quarantine.
