11 A culture of discipleship would be established in which making disciples is viewed as an ordinary part of the Christian life.

12 Transparent, meaningful relationships would become normal and remaining anonymous strange.

13 We would have unity in the midst of diversity—loving those with whom we have nothing in common but the gospel.

14 The church would grow in being distinct from the world in love & holiness, even as we seek to engage the world.

15 Giving would be faithful, as well as joyful, consistent, and sacrificial.

16 The church's teachers grow in dedication to God's Word even when no one's watching.

17 Faithful elders would shepherd God's flock well & faithful deacons would lead us well in service and mercy ministry

18 Leaders and members would remain above reproach, kept from temptation, complacency, idols, & worldliness.

19 The staff would be strengthened and encouraged in ministry and not become weary in well-doing.

20 God would grant us authentic community in which longsuffering, forgiveness and grace would be hallmarks of the church.

21 All of God's people would seek to use their gifts and resources for His glory and the good of others.

22 The Holy Spirit would forge and form within us more of the likeness & character of Jesus.

23 We would repent of the idols of our hearts and find in Christ the true source of satisfaction and significance.

24 God would grant us boldness and compassion to actively share the gospel among those with whom we live, work and play.

25 The gospel would spread throughout the world for the glory, honor and praise of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

26 God would be pleased to bring countless university students to a saving knowledge of Christ and equip them to be used of Him in this world.

27 The least, the lost and the forgotten would come to know the love of Christ.

28 We would seek to bring God glory in our various vocational callings.

29 Through the Scriptures we would increasingly learn to see all of life from God's perspective in order to live all of life for God's glory.
