The Gospel

God is holy - Isaiah 6:3b - “Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!”

God is just - Deuteronomy 32:4 - “The Rock, His work is perfect, for all His ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and upright is He.”

God is loving - I John 4:10 (NIV) - “This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.”

Man is sinful - Romans 3:23 - “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

Sin’s penalty - Romans 6:23 - “For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Judgment is certain - Hebrews 9:27 - And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment.”

Jesus paid the debt - I Peter 3:18 (NIV 1984) - “For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit.”

Our response - Romans 10:9-11 - “If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. For the Scripture says, ‘everyone who believes in Him will not be put to shame.’”
