****Drop off and Pick up Instructions:** If this is your child's first visit, before heading to the classroom, stop by the information booth to fill out the registration form. After the registration form is complete, you will receive a name tag for your child and a claim card. This claim card displays a unique claim number, your child's name and your name. Take this claim card to the class room, give the card to the teacher and they will write the child's name on the attendance sheet and return the card to you. The number on the card is used to communicate with you during the service. If you see your child's number on the screen in the sanctuary, it means to come to the nursery information booth. This card is also used as part of our secure child pickup. Present the card to the teacher and the teacher releases your child. Only the person with the claim card; and whose name appears on the card, can pick up the child. If there are questions or concerns, see the hall supervisor on duty.
