386 - Average Sunday Service Attendance.

67 - Average Friday Service Attendance.

83 - Youth Group Attendance (30 of those are included in the Sunday Count, the others just attend Thursdays.

513 - Weekly Attendance Average (Sunday/Friday Services and non-Sunday Youth Group Attenders)

852 individual people attend Sunday services every month.

We are accounting for 509 active families.

That is a growth of 73 families over 2014. (See the Zone Project Sheet for more information)

With an average of 3 people per household, there are around 1680 people who call Liberty home! That is up from 1300 in 2013. (See the Zone Project Sheet for more information)



We had 195 visitor forms filled out at Guest Services and we followed up with almost every one via cards, letters, calls, and emails. We currently have 161 active partners.



Over 500 individual children attended Kingdom Kids in 2014 67 average attendance per week last year We are currently seeing over 80 per week

The are 33 volunteers in our children's ministry with 7 to 8 serving in rotation each Sunday.





We are renovating our old pre-school room into a private space for nursing mothers. We are currently working on streaming video of our service into this space.

Our Children's ministry implemented a computer check-in system this year along with other security measures to accommodate the growth. Our children's ministry maintains safety and security as a high priority.







Average attendance of 83 middle and high school students per week in 2014 representing more than 200 students most of which come regularly.

We are currently seeing over 100 students per week.

There are 32 volunteers in our youth ministry with 12 serving each week.





We added a 48 passenger bus to our fleet this year and wrapped our 26 passenger to better reach the kids of the community. We now bus in nearly 90 kids every week to youth ministry.

With the favor we have received with bussing students from First Flight Middle School, we have begun an after school program on Thursdays prior to youth group.



This past year we focused on expanding our leadership structure of our Liberty Groups. Michael and Victoria Clayton began to help us develop and plan for rapid expansion of groups in 2015 to help accommodate the discipleship and community needs of our growing church.

In 2014 we focused our classes to target specific areas of spiritual growth. We held a parenting class, a class on core doctrines of the Christian faith, and a study of the fruit of the Holy Spirit. In addition we continued our verse by verse studies through Genesis and 1 Corinthians. We also held 3 Connect classes.



In September of 2014 we launched our school of ministry. We are providing a deeply relational and community driven discipleship opportunity to those pursuing God's call on their lives. We believe that as people step into God's calling on their lives, embodying His values, we will see His Kingdom unfolded on the earth.

We are offering full and part time programs that include classroom learning as well as community events and service opportunities

God's Faithfulness Through You

Total Tithes, Offerings, and Income for 2014 \$768,524.82

- General Offering \$612,512.82
- Designated Gifts \$150,835.92
- Other Income \$5,176.08 (This was internship funding, account interest, sales tax refunds, etc.)

Total Expenses

- Operating Expenses \$371,127.74
 - This includes facility maintenance, insurances, office supplies and equipment, ministry budgets, benevolence, utilities, etc.
- Staffing Expenses \$364,747.98
 - This includes the salaries, hourly wages, insurance, benefits, taxes, and training/conferences for pastors, administrator, secretaries, hourly employees, and contracted workers

What did we do with the remaining \$32,650.00?

 Any remaining funds for the year have been rolled into the new year.

Missions Giving - \$107,582.83

 We give a base line amount of 10% of last year's budget to missions work. Additional money comes in through fundraisers and designated gifts. The total missions giving this year was 18.6%!

Savings

 We put 5% to 10% of the undesignated funds from the offering each week into savings.

Endowment Fund

- An Endowment Fund has been given for the church with a beginning principle of \$5000.00 dollars.
- Gifts can be made to the Liberty Christian Fellowship Fund to grow the principle and are tax deductible
- Each year the interest on the principle will given to the church for ministry purposes and expansion
