78 - Average Friday Service Attendance.

661 – Weekly Attendance Average (Sunday/Friday Services and Youth Group)

996 individual people attend Sunday services every month.

We are accounting for 543 active families.

That is a growth of 34 families over 2014.

With an average of 3 people per household, there are around 1731 people who call Liberty home! That is up from 1680 in 2014.



We had over 200 visitors fill out a Connect Card and we followed up with almost every one via cards, letters, calls, and emails. We currently have 161 active partners.



Over 550 individual children attended Kingdom Kids in 2015 82 average attendance per week last year We currently are averaging 87 per week

The are currently 28 volunteers in our children's ministry with 7 to 8 serving in rotation each Sunday.





We updated some of our equipment and the themes of our children's worship space to better engage them with the Gospel.

We broadened our Easter and Fall family outreaches in 2015 and saw several hundred people from our community come to the church property and be exposed to our Kingdom Kids family.





Average attendance of 90 middle and high school students per week in 2015 representing more than 230 students most of which come regularly.

We are currently seeing 120 students per week.

There are 20 volunteers in our youth ministry with 15 serving each week.





We continue to bus in nearly 90 kids every week to youth ministry. In addition to Thursday night's meeting, we are running a ministry called Pre-Rise for students who come straight from school on Thursdays. We encourage them, feed them, and build relationships.

We expanded our youth intern ministry to raise leaders and further the ministry.

We have almost completed renovations for the Discipleship Classroom to also be overflow for youth group on Thursday Nights.



We invested in the next steps of our small group ministry in 2015 by launching new groups, encouraging leaders, and preparing for Katherine Hopkins to take the helm of the program.

In 2015, we focused our classes on grounding people in the word and the core beliefs of the faith. We held continuing verse by verse studies in the books of 2 Corinthians and Mark as well as launched a Foundations Class that covers the core beliefs of the faith.



In September of 2014 we launched our school of ministry. As we expanded through 2015, we saw people from many different demographics walk together in community, study, and ministry. We believe that as people step into God's calling on their lives, embodying His values, we will see His Kingdom unfolded on the earth.

Total Tithes, Offerings, and Income for 2015 \$964,794.09

(That is an increase of \$196,269.27 over 2014)

- General Offering \$745,939.85
- Designated Gifts \$77,659,46
- Other Income \$2889.55 (This was reimbursements and sales tax refunds, etc.)
- Pass Through \$138,305.23 passed through our account designated to Camp Emmanuel, Love Offerings, and Sponsored International Students

\$109,822.40 of last years giving came through online giving. That was as tremendous increase over 2014.

Total Expenses

- Operating Expenses \$505,431.74
 - This includes facility maintenance, insurances, office supplies and equipment, ministry budgets, benevolence, utilities, etc.
- Staffing Expenses \$417,245.84
 - This includes the salaries, hourly wages, insurance, benefits, taxes, and training/conferences for pastors, administrator, secretaries, hourly employees, and contracted workers

What did we do with the remaining \$42,116.51

 Any remaining funds for the year have been rolled into the new year.

Missions Giving - \$71,620.93

 We give a base line amount of 10% of last year's nondesignated income to missions work. Additional money comes in through fundraisers and designated gifts. The total missions giving in 2015 was 11.6%

Endowment Fund

- An Endowment Fund was given for the church in 2014 with a beginning principle of \$5000.00 dollars.
- Gifts can be made to the Liberty Christian Fellowship Fund to grow the principle and are tax deductible
- Each year the interest on the principle will given to the church for ministry purposes and expansion
