Reasons to Rejoice: God chose us even though he knows us

Recently I was looking for a vehicle for my daughter. She was a new driver and we needed something for her to drive. So, I looked for a vehicle that was unsafe and known to have poor reliability. Secondarily, I wanted very high mileage on the odometer, lots of rust, and as many stains and rips in the interior as possible. Old, worn-out tires would be an added bonus! Of course, I am joking! To choose a car like the one described above would be foolish.

For my daughter's car, more than anything else, I wanted a vehicle that was safe and reliable. Secondary considerations were gas mileage, a low-reading on the odometer, minimal rust outside, minimal damage or stains inside, newer tires etc.

I searched diligently for the best vehicle we could afford on our limited budget, and I purposely did not consider purchasing vehicles that were unsafe, unreliable or falling apart. It is right and good to want the best vehicle for our daughter. But I'm sure glad God does not use the same sort of process when choosing His family members.

Romans 8:29 says that "God knew His people in advance, and He chose them to become like His Son, so that His Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters." God did not look over all of creation and choose the best and the brightest. He did not weigh our strengths and weaknesses, or choose us because He needed us to fulfill Him. He did not look for those with low mileage and new tires.

I was blessed to find a good car for my daughter. <u>But</u>, there were no guarantees. There was no way for me to really know for sure if it would be a good car or a lemon. The remarkable thing about God choosing us is that He knows us completely and he chose us anyway! He knows all our sinful tendencies and shortcomings. He knows about the rust on the outside and the rips on the inside and He chose us anyway. He chose us because He is good and loving and not because we are a safe bet.

He chose us to become like His Son, to be conformed to the image of His son. God chose us knowing that we need some body work and repairs and constant maintenance. God chose you even though he knew you. That is a reason to rejoice!



James 4:7 // SURRENDER ALL


