Baptism & the Lord's Supper

In the New Testament, the church is given two required ordinances to follow: Baptism and the Lord's Supper. While they are both very powerful symbols of the Lord's death and resurrection, they are also public professions and identifications that we belong to the Church, the Body of Christ.

Baptism is the first step of obedience for a follower of Jesus. It is the believer's public profession of faith in Christ. In Romans 6, Paul says, "We are buried with Christ in baptism and raised to walk in newness of life." One of our pastors or elders would love to talk to you about taking this step of faith and obedience.

For baptized believers, the Lord's Supper is the remembrance of what that baptism represents: Jesus's body was broken & his blood was spilled to wash away our sin. Through the preaching of the Word and the worship of the saints, we HEAR the gospel. As we take the Lord's Supper together this morning, we SEE the gospel.
