“No Greater Love”

Faith Church ~ Good Friday Service

12 Pilate answered and said to them again, "What then do you want me to do *with Him* whom you call the King of the Jews?" 13 So they cried out again, "Crucify Him!" 14 Then Pilate said to them, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they cried out all the more, "Crucify Him!" 15 So Pilate, wanting to gratify the crowd, released Barabbas to them; and he delivered Jesus, after he had scourged *Him*, to be crucified. Mark 15:12-15 (NKJV)

16 Then the soldiers led Him away into the hall called Praetorium, and they called together the whole garrison. 17 And they clothed Him with purple; and they twisted a crown of thorns, put it on His *head*, 18 and began to salute Him, "Hail, King of the Jews!" 19 Then they struck Him on the head with a reed and spat on Him; and bowing the knee, they "worshipped" Him. 20 And when they had mocked Him, they took the purple off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him out to crucify Him. Mark 15:16-19 (NKJV)

22 And they brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull...²⁴ And when they crucified Him, they divided His garments, casting lots for them to determine what every man should take. ²⁵ Now it was the third hour, and they crucified Him. ²⁶ And the inscription of His accusation was written above: THE KING OF THE JEWS. Mark 15:22-26 (NKJV)

shall be able to separate us from the love of
God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.**

20 In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you. Lk 22



6. Jesus is scourged and crowned with thorns






