LEARNING OUR FAITH:

Spurgeon's Catechism Question #9

Q. What is the work of creation?

A. The work of creation is God's making all things (Genesis 1:1) of nothing, by the Word of his power, (Hebrews 11:3) in six normal consecutive days, (Ezekiel 20:11) and all very good. (Genesis 1:31)

Commentary

God's miraculous work began when He created the world *ex nihilio*, "out of nothing," not providentially through evolution, but perfectly and instantaneously.

MODERN STATEMENTS TO KNOW:

The Nashville Statement (2017)

A new and controversial statement from a broad swath of evangelicals, the Nashville affirms the biblical view of sexuality. The initial signatories include John MacArthur, R. C. Sproul, and a number of other notable names. Each week, we'll take a look at an article from it, and the full statement is available online at https://cbmw.org/nashville-statement.

Article 9

WE AFFIRM that sin distorts sexual desires by directing them away from the marriage covenant and toward sexual immorality— a distortion that includes both heterosexual and homosexual immorality.

WE DENY that an enduring pattern of desire for sexual immorality justifies sexually immoral behavior.

Commentary

God did indeed create human beings with sexual desire, but it was meant to lead toward procreation and to be a blessing in a marriage relationship. Sin causes these desires to become disordered. We should never consider such a disordering God's validation of sinful behaviors. Instead, we should repent of thoughts, desires, and deeds that are outside the Lord's will, trusting in His grace to grant us the will and the working of His good pleasure (Phil 2:12–13).
