### Offering



Welcome to the Lord's Day worship service at Grace Bible Church. We are truly blessed to be here this morning as we open God's Word together, sing His praises, and enjoy a time of fellowship in His presence.

On this Lord's Day we commemorate the 503rd anniversary of the Protestant Reformation begun October 31, 1517, when Martin Luther, a German Augustinian monk, nailed 95 theses to the door of the Wittenburg Castle Church on the eve of All Saints' Day. Our church stands gratefully on the shoulders of the great Reformers whose courageous work rescued the gospel from a fog of medieval corruptions. Their battle cries of *Sola Scriptura*, *Solus Christus*, *Sola Fide*, *Sola Gratia*, and *Soli Deo Gloria* remain the foundational principles of our church today.
