December 31st we once again prayed John Wesley's covenant service together. Recommitting ourselves to this life devoted to God and reminding ourselves of our need for God. It is a good to reset and refocus ourselves on our relationship with God.

We should not lose sight of the reality that our faith is always a response to what God is doing! The goodness is that Christ doesn't need a covenant renewal service to remember God's side of the covenant. Christ is always seeking relationship with us, seeking to invite us into a fuller relationship with the divine.

We step into a new year with unwritten days and wide open pages, but we are not alone! The God who created us and called us GOOD is with us, with

you, always. God will not forsake us and will always forgive and welcome and delight in us. Begin this year knowing that you are loved and that Christ calls to you!

But it's often difficult to remember the natural patterns of our childhood selves that enabled us to live freely in God's wonder-filled presence. Is childlike faith simply an unquestioning faith, or is it being present with ourselves in a way that invites healing and wholeness?

Faith Like a Child considers Jesus' invitation to childlike faith and explores seven distinct ways of welcoming the child within. Offering wisdom from years of experience as a spiritual director with both adults and children, Lacy Finn Borgo explores practices to welcome and enliven your childhood self. Offering examples of what becoming like children could look like, Borgo invites you to take Jesus up on his offer to live more deeply into a relationship with God.

As we welcome our childhood selves, we allow God to heal our wounds so we can live in freedom with Jesus as our companion.
