

We started the book study on Thursday, December 11th. **We will continue to meet on Thursdays at noon.** There is still time to join us. This study considers how a camera can help us open “the eyes of the heart.” More than a book on photographic technique, *Eyes of the Heart* is about cultivating photography as a spiritual practice through visio divina (sacred seeing). Each week we will enter into a photographic journey in which the reader does not simply take images, but receives images and learns to see with “the eyes of the heart” (Eph 1:18).

Yadkin Christian Ministries

Every month the Missions Committee is focusing on a Mission Outreach project. It may be a local non-profit or a UMC Ministry. This month, we are focusing on Yadkin Christian Ministries.

Yadkin Christian Ministries, formed in 1985, is a cooperative effort of churches, individuals, and non-profit agencies unified for the purpose of sharing Christ's love by providing food and other necessities for people in need within Yadkin County.

Each week, trained volunteers gather at the Yadkinville and East Bend locations to minister to people in need. Some of those volunteers are from our church. Food is provided, and assistance with medicine, and many other necessities of life are made available. All assistance is paid directly to the provider. No cash is distributed to clients.

YCM is supported entirely by private contributions, fundraisers, and grants. If you would like to contribute to the YCM fund, make your check payable to YUMC and memo it "YCM."

Residents of Boonville, East Bend, Hamptonville, and Yadkinville are served by YCM. Jonesville residents are served by Tri-County Christian Crisis Ministry (336-526-1089).

This National Day of Caring celebrates 35 years of empowering youth and uniting communities to address hunger. Dr. Brad Smith could

not have envisioned that twenty- two churches joining together in Columbia, South Carolina, to collect money and food for the needy in that community in 1990 would grow into a nationwide effort that has collect more than \$100 million for soup kitchens, food banks, and community charities.

Hunger and poverty are a nationwide problem that affects every community. In America, 1 in 8 people face hunger every day. In Northwest North Carolina, 1 in 5 children go without enough food to thrive. In Yadkin County, 16% of our residents face food insecurity.

In Yadkin County, Yadkin Christian Ministries locations in East Bend and Yadkinville, see clients daily who cannot provide the basic needs of their families. Many children live with food insecurity and many of our senior citizens make the hard choice of eating or purchasing much needed medications. We need to join together to help those less fortunate.
