ReNew with Connect Clothing Closet

The Yadkinville UMC ReNew with Connect Closet began after NETworX Yadkin had a yard sale and didn't sale all of the clothing. During the time that followed, YUMC had quite a few people visiting who were showering and/or homeless.

Everyone wants/needs/deserves a bath and clean clothes. The clothes from NETworX Yadkin's yard sale gave so many dignity and helped them feel positive.

Now, we have a place where anyone can come and search for clothes, shoes, handbags, costume jewelry, and more. Because of many generous donations, we have men's, women's, and children's clothing. We have dedicated volunteers who sort the clothes and serve as greeters to patrons who come to "shop".

The ReNew with Connect Clothing Closet is also a place for school social workers to come to find clothing for not only students but for a family in need. It a place for students that are looking to serve God and community can get volunteer hours. Other local nonprofits like Partners Behavior Health and Domestic Violence have also "shopped" for their clients as well. As word continues to spread, we are hearing from other churches asking how they can help, too!

While the items in the closet are donated, the storage containers, clothing racks, etc, are not. When you wonder how you can help, a monetary donation will help with the cost of maintaining those type things. An hour a month volunteering will help you in ways that cannot be described.
