

Greetings PCC Family and Friends,

We are very excited to begin offering in-person worship services on September 27, 2020. We are taking every precaution to help people be safe and feel comfortable while attending our worship services. Below are the guidelines we have set in place for coming back to church.

#### Guidelines for Coming Back to Church

1. Masks are required for everyone three years and older.
2. Temperature checks will be done before entering the building.
3. Social distancing will be practiced throughout the church building and property.
4. Seating is taped off in the worship center to practice social distancing. Please don't take up more chairs than your party needs. If there are only two people in you party, try to find two seats together or three if necessary. Don't take up four or five seats. We will also have overflow seating in the fellowship hall with the service projected on the wall. You may wish to sit in the overflow section and that is fine. This may be a great option for families.
5. There is not a nursery, children's ministry classes, or youth classes at this time. These programs will resume at a later date. Families will sit together in the worship service.
6. We are doing everything possible to create a low-touch service. Most doors will be opened for you or propped open. We will not be handing out bulletins, passing communion plates, or offering bags. Pre-packaged communion can be picked up upon entering the worship center and offerings can be placed in the baskets provided. Please refrain from shaking hands or hugging.
7. We will not be asking anyone to come front during the response time. Mike will be available after each service to pray with people and to meet any new guests.
8. We will be cleaning and disinfecting the building before, during, and after each service.

We will continue to monitor these guidelines and make necessary adjustments as we go along.

Please do not come to church if you are at risk, not feeling well, or uncomfortable being here right now. You can continue to worship with us online.

We ask you all to be supportive and flexible as we come back to church. We need your help and cooperation to do this safely and effectively.

Please feel free to invite your family and friends. Everyone is welcome. Please share this information with those you invite and with anyone who might be interested. We are very excited to being together as a church family and we hope you will join us.
