we pray that you would allow us to sink into this song.

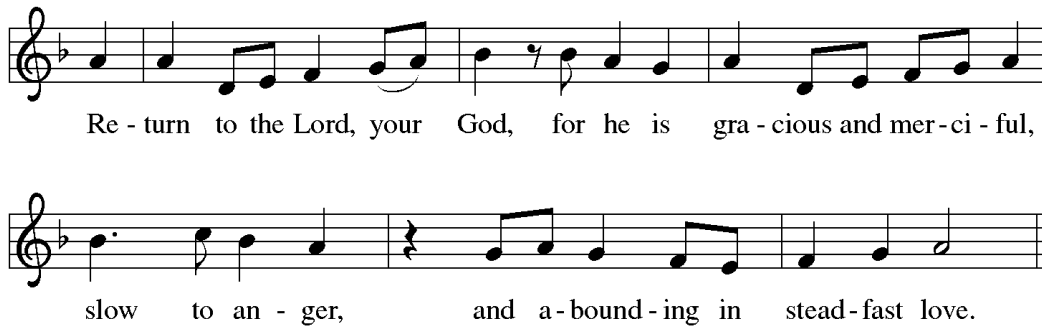
Allow us to hear the truth in between the words.
