# **Avenue 1:**

### In His Steps by Charles Sheldon

 This book, first published in the 1880s, is a fictional story about a church that decides to adopt a simple slogan to guide their every decision: What Would Jesus Do? When it was first published, this book caused a sensation and has continued to find a wide readership, becoming one of the bestselling books of all time. It will challenge us as Christians to take our discipleship to Jesus seriously.

#### The Truth in Jesus by George MacDonald

This short essay, written by influential thinker and author George MacDonald, challenges
Christians to leave behind arguments and opinions about Jesus and put their trust in Him
directly through active obedience and trust. George MacDonald was a unique and
creative voice and his works that spanned multiple genres have influenced many
generations of Christians including C.S. Lewis (who called him his "master"), J.R.R. Tolkien,
G.K. Chesterton, Madeleine L'Engle, and Lewis Carroll.

# **Avenue 3:**

#### Christ, The Sum of All Spiritual Things by Watchman Nee

• This short book, like the other two resources suggested, is about returning to Jesus as the foundation of our faith and cultivating a living connection to Him, rather than merely having ideas about Him. Watchman Nee was an influential leader, author, and evangelist in the Chinese church. He was arrested by the Communist Party during the takeover in the 50s and spent 20 years in prison for his faith, which he refused to renounce. Watchman Nee died in prison, but his writings live on and have influenced countless Christians around the world to deepen their trust in Jesus.
