

The Top 10 Reasons to Join the Choir for Easter

Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth. Sing to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples.” (Psalm 145:4)

While it feels like we just wrapped up our Christmas cantata a few weeks ago (which we did!), Easter is coming up quickly on April 5, which means it’s almost time to start rehearsals for the Easter cantata. If you love to sing, we’d love for you to join us, and if you’re on the fence, here are the top 10 reasons why you should come sing with us:

1. **Spiritual Growth:** music helps to deepen your relationship with God and to express your praise for who God is and what He has done. Singing with the choir is a profoundly spiritual experience.
2. **Sense of Belonging and Community:** the choir is a family within the family of the church, and is a place to form strong bonds and connections with likeminded individuals as we prepare some really wonderful music. It’s in groups like this where FBC really does become “*a HOME for Your Faith*”!
3. **Stress Relief and Mental Health:** Singing releases endorphins, improves mood, and offers a creative outlet, which are all things that reduce stress!
4. **Boost Your Confidence:** Gain self-assurance as your voice strengthens! Our group is really supportive and encouraging, even if you are new to singing in a choir.
5. **Learn & Improve Music Skills:** This time around, we will really be focusing on improving vocal technique and we’ll help you learn to read music if you don’t know how!
6. **Serve the Church and Community:** Our cantatas are attended by a wide range of people in the Seymour area, so this is a great way to get involved and use the gift of music to serve and reach the community with the message of the Gospel.
7. **Physical Benefits:** Singing acts as a mini-workout and helps improve your posture and core strength.
8. **Cognitive Benefits:** Singing is a complex brain activity that helps to enhance memory, concentration and brain function!
9. **It’s an Uplifting Experience:** Participation in creating beautiful music elevates your spirit and encourages others in the process.
10. **It’s FUN!** Our rehearsals are filled with laughter, fun and fellowship, and many say that it is a highlight of their week.

The FBC Choir is open to all singers 6th grade and above and rehearsals will be starting in early February for this year’s cantata, *Testimony of Life*, by Joseph Martin (one of the great American choral composers of the last 40 years!).
