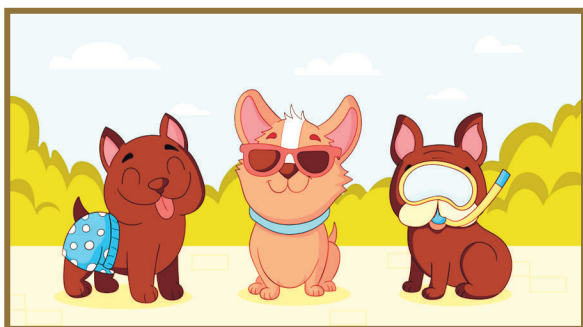

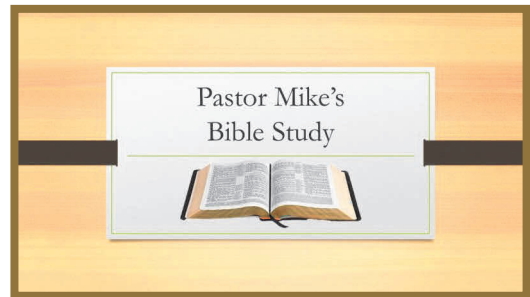

**Interesting Days in**

**June 5<sup>th</sup> is World Environment Day**—a day meant to raise environmental awareness across the globe.

**June 14<sup>th</sup> is Flag Day (U.S.)**. Be sure to raise the flag!

**June 18<sup>th</sup> is Father's Day** this year.

**June 19<sup>th</sup> is Juneteenth** (also known as **Freedom Day** or **Emancipation Day**). On this day in 1865, Union General Gordon Granger read the Emancipation Proclamation aloud in Galveston, Texas, effectively liberating enslaved people in the state, which had thus far been beyond control of the Union Army.

**June 21<sup>st</sup> is the summer solstice**, which heralds the start of summer in the Northern Hemisphere. It's the day with the most hours of daylight, so enjoy! In the Southern Hemisphere, winter begins at this time.

**June 24<sup>th</sup> brings Midsummer Day**, traditionally the midpoint of the growing season, halfway between planting and harvesting. It is celebrated in many cultures on the night of **June 23<sup>rd</sup>**, as **Midsummer Evening**.
