

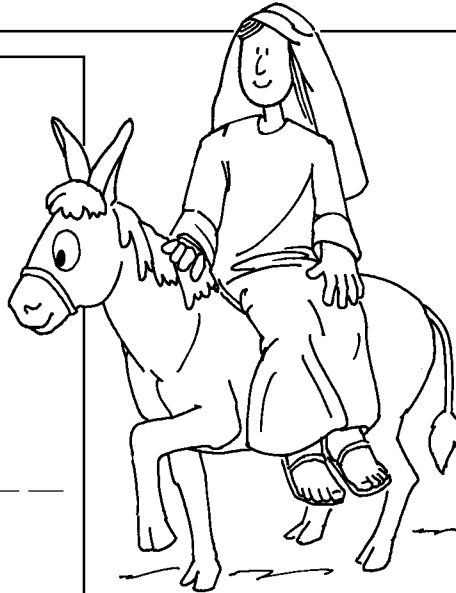


David listened to Abigail and praised her good judgment. When Abigail told Nabal the story, his heart failed and he died. David then asked Abigail to be his wife. What happened next?

Follow the paths of the maze to read David and Nabal's words.

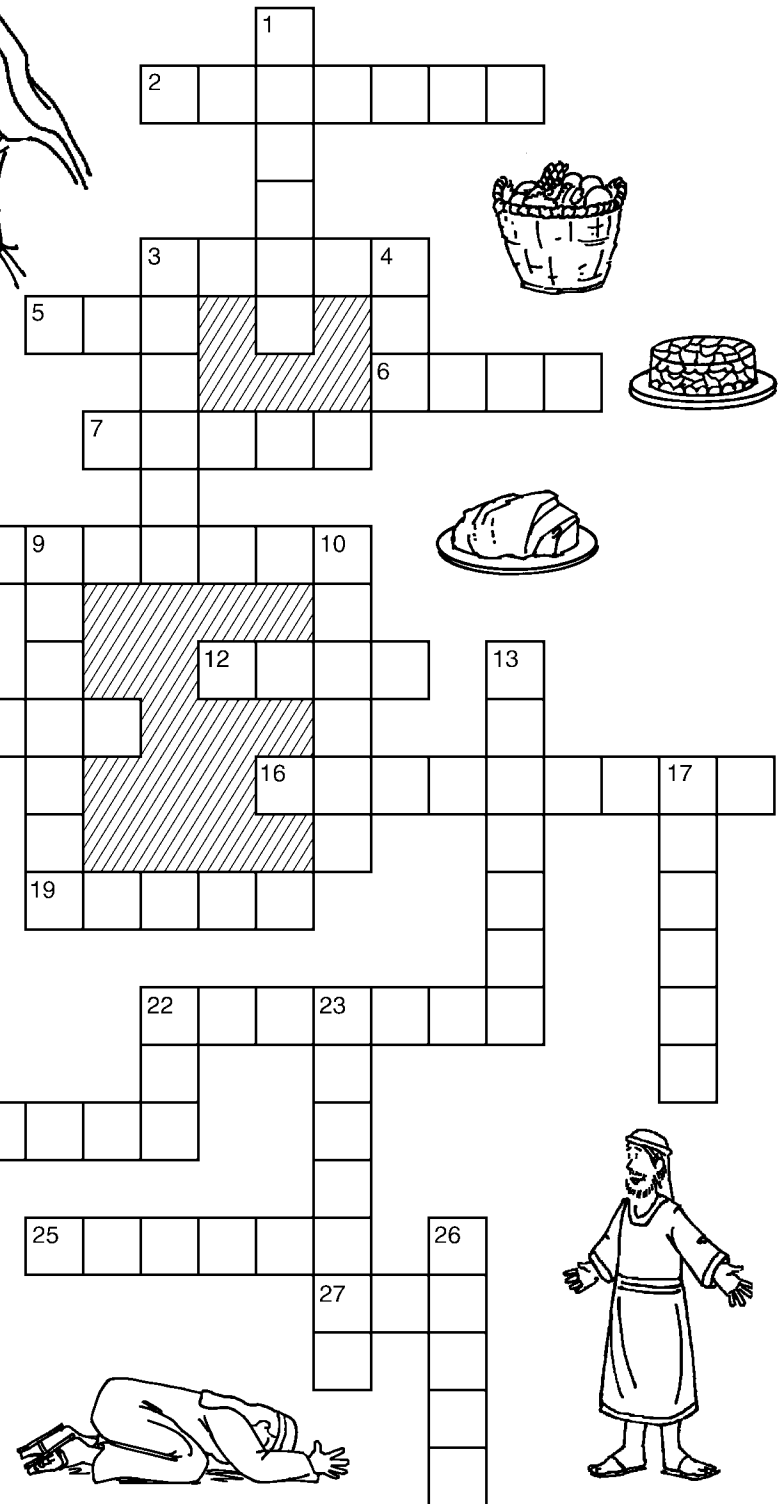
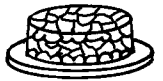
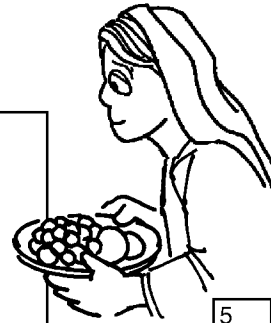
