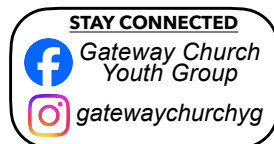

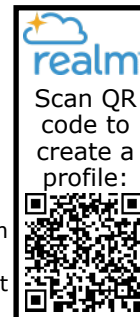

If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. I may have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. I give all my possessions to feed the hungry, I give all my body to be burned, if I surrender my love, it profits me nothing. Love does not despise or is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, does not act unbecomingly. It does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take account of a wrong suffered, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. But now faith, hope, love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love.
