

What is Faith Promise

Faith Promise Sunday happens once each year. On this Sunday, we focus our attention on the "in the nations" part of our mission statement, which reads in full: "To make Christlike disciples in all nations." As one local church, we can't reach all the nations by ourselves. We need teammates. God has blessed us with Nazarene teammates in more than 160 world areas, who are spreading the Gospel on our behalf to a world in desperate need of Jesus. Once a year, we invite every household in our church to stretch their faith by making a promise to support global missions throughout the coming year over and above their regular tithes and offerings.

Faith Promise, our missions emphasis, is much more than a pledge drive. It is an opportunity to partner with God for the coming year. We ask God "How much would you like to channel through me in order to support mission outreach around the world?" The answer sometimes surprises us. He may ask us to commit to more than we expect, so that He can bless others through us as we trust Him to provide.
