Monday, March 16 (Genesis 14:20) "Blessed by Abram by God Most High, creator of heaven and earth, and blessed be God Most High for handing over your enemies to you." And Abram gave him a tithe of everything.

You could hear the emotion, you could feel the electricity in the air! Abram's nephew had been taken prisoner by an invading army. At best the nephew would be sold into slavery and at worst he would be tortured for entertainment and murdered. But either way he would be lost to his family.

Abram, patriarch of the family, was a man of action. This was intolerable and Abram would do what needed to be done. "Sound the alarm! Call all the male servants and men of the family! Pass out the spears and shields! My nephew is in danger and we are going to go get him back!"
